Typical Meeting Service Positions

Typical service positions of a CoDA Group as suggested in the Fellowship Service Manual are:

- * Chairperson
- * Secretary
- * Treasurer
- * Literature person

- * Refreshment person(s)
- * Phone list person
- * Group Service Representative

Group Service Representative (GSR) is the link between the CoDA group and CoDA as a whole. Ideally, a GSR is an established member of the group, with experience, knowledge, and understanding of CoDA's Twelve Steps and Twelve Tradition (usual term is 2 years):

- * Attends the local CoDA Intergroup or Voting Entity service meetings.
- * Carries the group conscience to the local CoDA Intergroup, Voting Entity service meeting; and then reports to the group on the outcomes.
- * Notifies the group of any local or CoDA, Inc. updates, announcements, and flyers.

I've felt various feelings during these weekends: sad, anger, anxious, peace, joy, frustrated, shy, embarrassed, depressed, ashamed, happy, serene, etc. Retreats are bridges that connect me with my inner self and to my Higher Power. I also have an opportunity to connect with other codependents on a level that is different than my day-to-day life. I always get something out of the weekend. The setting is peaceful; there is a lake behind the building with lots of trees and land to "walk about." A massage is \$50 to \$70 for only an hour.
